



EMISA's Privacy Statement

We acknowledge the importance of your privacy protection and rights attached to it. The following section will explain what personal data EMISA collects from you, how we store it, use it, and lastly, how you can request an adjustment and/or erasure of your personal data.

EMISA operates with enterprises located worldwide, beyond the scope of the EU. However, we value the privacy of our visitors and members equally, regardless of the origin or other discriminatory grounds. The following details in this privacy statement refer to services of EMISA, the website and apps we use for EMISA members' interaction, social media, servers and third-party agreements.

What data do we collect?

We collect data, such as your name, last name, email address, phone number, and name of the company you are affiliated with.

How do we collect your data?

Most of your data is provided directly to EMISA. This includes registering your company and personal information on the EMISA website, sending an email or contacting us via other means, registering for an EMISA event, connecting with EMISA on social media. We also obtain data from third parties.

Do we use cookies?

EMISA does not use cookies.

Do we use your data for advertising purposes?

EMISA does not use your data for advertising purposes.

Why do we collect such data?

EMISA collects personal data to ensure an efficient operation and optimize the user's experience.

How do we use your data?

We treat your personal data confidentially and do not share it with third parties unless necessary for ensuring efficient operation and/or optimizing your experience.



EMISA uses the data we collect to operate and provide you the services we offer. EMISA also uses your data to communicate with you, for example, sending a newsletter or communicating by other means.

We only share your personal data with your consent or as necessary to complete any transaction or provide any service you have requested or authorised.

Where do we store it?

EMISA operates through a Dutch data processor/controller. The Dutch data processor/controller is, just like EMISA, obliged to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation and protect your privacy at the same level.

Is EMISA working with any third parties that have access to your personal data?

We work with a Dutch data processor/controller. They make sure that your data is stored accurately and safely.

How long do we keep your data?

We keep your data as long as the purpose for such retention exists. For example, if you are a member of EMISA, we will store the necessary data for the period of your membership. In an unlikely event of terminating your membership, all your data will be erased within 45 working days after your membership has been terminated.

How can your data be adjusted/erased?

A quick guide on some of your rights:

- You have the right to know about who your data processor and data controller are.
- You have the right to data portability.
- You have the right to access to information.
- You have the right of correction (rectification).
- You have the right to be forgotten (erasure).



- You have the rights in the scope of consent (if that's the legal ground for processing).
